Co-Curricular Attainment	Details
Excellent	Student who attains a minimum Level 3 in all four domains with at least a Level 4 in one domain.
Good	Student who attains a minimum Level 1 in all four domains with any one of the following: i. At least Level 2 in three domains; ii. At least Level 2 in one domain and at least Level 3 in another domain; or iii. At least Level 4 in one domain.
Satisfactory	Student who attains a minimum Level 1 in all four domains
Need Improvement	Student who fails to attain a minimum Level 1 in all four domains

2. Important Notes

- Secondary level students are allowed to accumulate their achievements over the course of their secondary education.
- Students who complete their secondary education will be awarded a certificate and transcript based on the criteria above.
- Pre-U students are allowed to accumulate their achievements over the course of their Pre-University education.
- Students who complete their Pre-University education will be awarded a certificate and transcript based on the criteria above.

Involvement in events whereby participation is mass in nature and/or does not require training, preparation or selection will also not be recognised in this domain.
- ⁵ Intra-School Events refer to intra-school competitions (SUKMA, inter-class competitions, etc), festivals, school performances / concerts, exhibitions and conferences. These events primarily do not include student participation from other schools and/or members of the public.
- ⁶ Events refer to competitions (eg MSG), festivals, school performances / concerts, exhibitions, conferences and symposiums.
